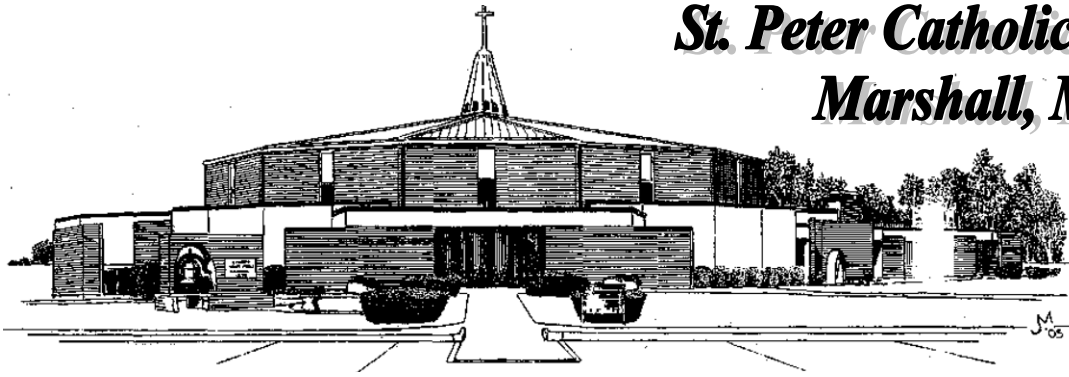

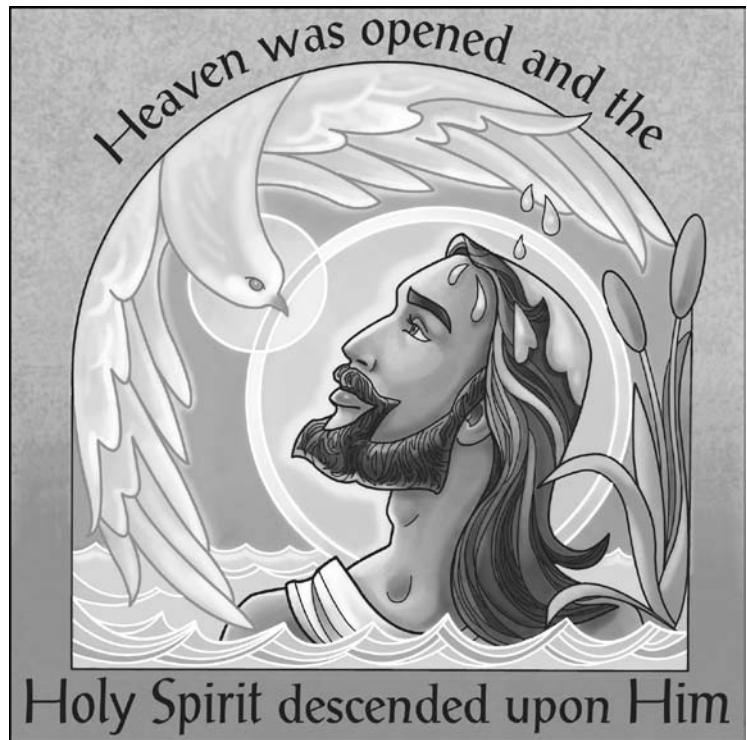

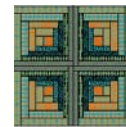

**GUMMING UP THE WORKS:** Some thoughts on chewing Gum in Church. (These thoughts were written by one of our priests in the Diocese.) Church writers have long thought of prayerful reflection on the Word of God as a form of chewing and rumination. Rather the Word of God than gum! It is a courtesy to those around you not to distract them during Mass by smacking gum, etc., but the fundamental reason not to chew gum is that it compromises the attention and therefore the respect that we all must give to the Blessed Sacrament. Though gum is not food (as mouth wash, toothpaste, medicine, breath mints are not food) and does not generally violate the Eucharistic fast, it throws off signals to others at Mass and raises questions in others' heads. Why not just leave the gum in your car and have a piece when you come out. Think about it!
