**WHY ARE WE RINGING THOSE BELLS (GONG) IN CHURCH?** Just to be "old-fashioned"? No, the sacramentary has instructions on these things and the use of bells is totally optional. They don't need to be used. But most of us like the idea of making joyful noises at the solemn moments like the consecration. I hope the bells don't bother you. I rather like them. *Fr. Kevin.*

**WHY DO PEOPLE LEAVE CHURCH EARLY BEFORE THE LAST SONG** (or even right after Holy Communion time) I cannot answer that, but can imagine a number of good reasons.
