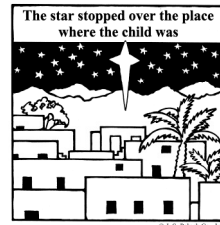

Do you feel a little guilty when you hear the Beatitudes proclaimed, or preached, or when you read them in your Bible? Maybe you need another look at this beautiful teaching of Jesus to fully discover the invitation Jesus has for YOU in the Beatitudes. Come and follow Jesus' call to live the Beatitudes. You will know blessing and goodness beyond your imagination.

January 8, 2012 - Today's Gospel reading reveals the story of the magi who come from the east to pay homage to Jesus, the newborn king. The story of the magi teaches Christian stewards three Christmas truths: God, in the

person of Jesus Christ is present and active in the world, and stewards must follow his star. Second, each of us, no matter our circumstances or station in life, has a gift to bring to the Lord. And finally, our life's journey always leads to Christ, even when at times we do not know where the road is heading.
