

And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and behold, I am with you always, to the close of the age." (Matthew 28:18-20)



Left to its own natural powers humanity does not have access to the "Father's house," to God's life and happiness. Only Christ can open to man such access that we, his members, might have confidence that we too shall go where he, our Head and our Source, has preceded us.

(Catechism of the Catholic Church 661)

"And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to myself." The lifting up of Jesus on the cross signifies and announces his lifting up by his Ascension into heaven, and indeed begins it. Jesus Christ, the one priest of the new and eternal Covenant, "entered, not into a sanctuary made by human hands... but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God on our behalf." There Christ permanently exercises his priesthood, for he "always lives to make intercession" for "those who draw near to God through him." As "high priest of the good things to come" he is the center and the principal actor of the liturgy that honors the Father in heaven. (Catechism of the Catholic Church 662)

Christ is also with the Church "to the end of the age" in other ways, as well. However, He is uniquely and most importantly Present in the Holy Eucharist, by means of which His Holy Sacrifice is remembered and made Present, in the gift of Himself in Holy Communion, and by remaining with us in our tabernacles. In all these ways the continuity and unity of Christ's redemptive ministry is guaranteed until He comes again (cf. John 16:13-15, 17:2-21).

PARISH AND COMMUNITY ANNOUNCEMENTS

There will be NO WEEKDAY MASSES the week of June 9–13. This is Father Francis' retreat week. The parish office will be open Monday—Thursday only. Hours may fluctuate.



If you would like to offer Mass intentions, we have many openings available. Come by the office to schedule. Masses may be offered for a deceased individual, someone who is sick or suffering, to give thanks to God for a specific event, to celebrate an anniversary, or for a prayer intention (as long as the intention does not contradict Church teaching). The requested fee (determined by diocesan policy) is \$10.00 per Mass.

The practice of offering Mass for particular intentions is an ancient one, dating back to the early Church. In accord with the approved practice of the Church, any priest celebrating or concelebrating is permitted to receive an offering to apply the Mass for a specific intention (Canon 945) "The Christian faithful who make an offering so that the Mass may be applied for their intention contribute to the good of the Church and by their offering take part in the concern of the

In the Catholic faith, attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation is a fundamental precept of our faith.

The Third Commandment is, "Remember to keep holy the Sabbath day" (Ex 20:8; see also Dt 5:12). The Christian Sabbath is Sunday, and Catholic's keep the Sabbath holy by fulfilling the obligation to attend Mass (Canons 1246-1248)

AN UPDATE FROM THE DIOCESE UNA ACTUALIZACIÓN DE LA DIÓCESIS



This past week, Archbishop Shawn McKnight's Coat of Arms were removed from above the bishop's chair in the Cathedral of St. Joseph. This act signifies the vacant seat *-sede vacante* in Latin that exists until such time as a we have a new bishop. This procedure is rooted in canon law and tradition dating back many centuries.

Now, the Diocesan College of Consultors will meet to elect a diocesan administrator for the Diocese of Jefferson City. The diocesan administrator will serve as the leader of the diocese until a new Bishop of Jefferson City is appointed by the Holy Father and takes canonical possession of the diocese. The diocesan administrator can fully govern the diocese and make all necessary decisions to safeguard it while awaiting the appointment of a new bishop, but must carry out and not alter all existing diocesan laws and policies.

The departure of a bishop does not nullify his policies. Clergy, religious, staff, and the faithful are expected to continue to work to fulfill the requirements that have been put in place in the diocese. There is no official time line for the selection of a new bishop. Once Pope Leo XIV has appointed a new bishop to lead the Diocese of Jefferson City, and he has accepted, the announcement will be published in the daily Vatican Bulletin. This could happen at any time. However, in recent similar situations, it has taken several months for a new bishop to be named. Let us pray for a bishop who will lead us in modesty, honor, and courage.

La semana pasada, el escudo de armas del arzobispo Shawn McKnight fue retirado de en-cima de la silla del obispo en la Catedral de San José. Este acto significa la sede vacante -sede vacante en latín- que existe hasta que tengamos un nuevo obispo. Este procedimiento tiene sus raíces en el derecho canónico y una tradición que se remonta a muchos siglos atrás.



Ahora, el Colegio Diocesano de Consultores se reunirá para elegir un administrador diocesano para la Diócesis de Jefferson City. El administrador diocesano servirá como líder de la diócesis hasta que un nuevo obispo de Jefferson City sea designado por el Santo Padre y tome pose sión canónica de la diócesis. El administrador diocesano puede go-bernar plenamente la diócesis y tomar todas l las decisiones necesarias para salvaguar-darla mientras se espera el nombramiento del nuevo obispo, pero debe cumplir y no modificar todas las leyes y políticas diocesanas vigentes. La salida de un obispo no anula sus políticas. Se espera que el clero, los religiosos, el personal y los fieles continúen tra-bajando para cumplir con los requisitos establecidos en la diócesis.

No existe un cronograma oficial para la selección de un nuevo obispo. Una vez que el Papa León XIV haya nombrado a un nuevo obispo para dirigir la Diócesis de Jefferson City, y este haya aceptado, el anuncio se publicará en el Boletín Vaticano. Esto podría ocurrir en cual-quier momento. Sin embargo, en situaciones similares recientes, el nombramiento de un nuevo obispo ha tardado varios meses. Oremos por un obispo que nos guíe con modestia, honor y valentía.
