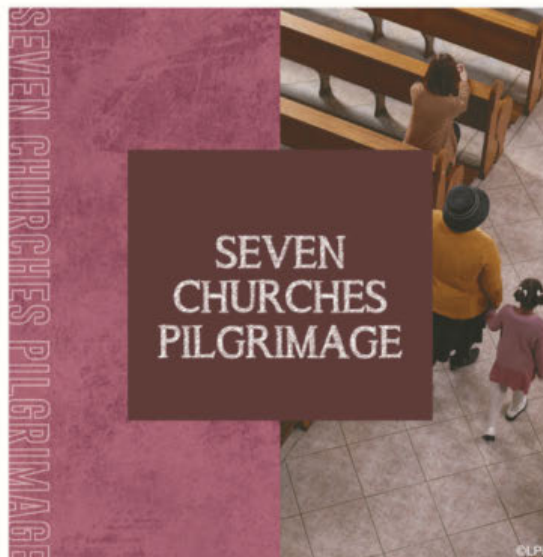

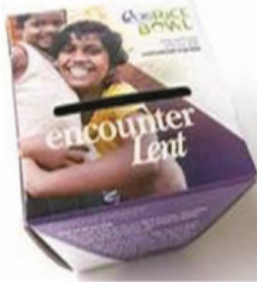


Devotions, *Explained!*

Why is the Easter Vigil Mass So Important?

The Easter Vigil is by far the most important and beautiful Mass of the entire year for it contains the Church's greatest promises. This is the night that sets Christian Believers apart from others. It is also a Mass that many Catholics, including those who otherwise take the faith very seriously, rarely attend. Perhaps because it is longer than a Sunday Mass and requires greater faith and love, since it's the opposite of the religious minimalism that looks for the fastest way to fulfill one's Sunday Mass "obligation". This Mass is like a banquet containing the most important lessons in the history of salvation. From the creation of the world, to the Passover of the Jewish people, to the night that Jesus passed over from death to life, our history unfolds before us. As we gather to keep that contemplative vigil, the priest makes an amazing promise: "If we keep the memorial of the Lord's paschal solemnity in this way, listening to his word and celebrating his mysteries, then we shall have the sure hope of sharing his triumph over death and living with him in God." The Church gives us assurance that she makes in no other liturgy throughout the year, promising that if we learn how to celebrate and live the Easter vigil, then we will share, in this life and forever, Jesus' victory over sin and death and abide in communion with him in the heart of the Trinity.



¿Por qué es tan importante la Misa de la Vigilia Pascual?

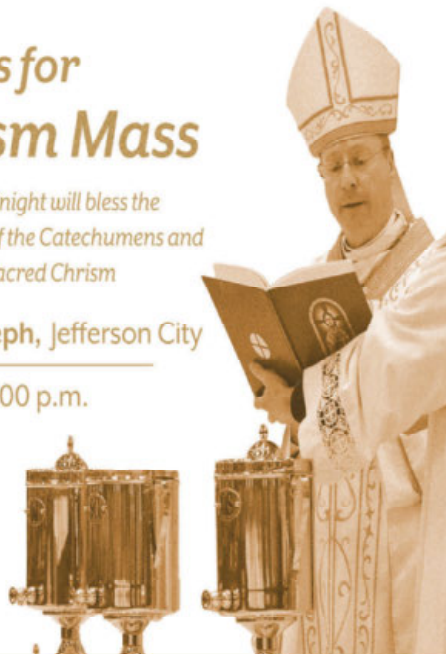
La Vigilia Pascual es, sin duda, la misa más importante y hermosa del año, pues contiene las mayores promesas de la Iglesia. Esta es la noche que distingue a los creyentes cristianos. También es una misa a la que muchos católicos, incluyendo a quienes se toman la fe muy en serio, rara vez asisten. Quizás porque es más larga que la misa dominical y requiere mayor fe y amor, ya que es lo opuesto al minimalismo religioso que busca la manera más rápida de cumplir con la obligación de la misa dominical. Esta misa es como un banquete que contiene las lecciones más importantes de la historia de la salvación. Desde la creación del mundo, pasando por la Pascua del pueblo judío, hasta la noche en que Jesús pasó de la muerte a la vida, nuestra historia se despliega ante nosotros. Al reunirnos para celebrar esa vigilia contemplativa, el sacerdote hace una promesa asombrosa: "Si celebramos así el memorial de la solemnidad pascual del Señor, escuchando su palabra y celebrando sus misterios, tendremos la esperanza segura de compartir su triunfo sobre la muerte y vivir con él en Dios" La Iglesia nos da una seguridad que no ofrece en ninguna otra liturgia del año, prometiendo que si aprendemos a celebrar y vivir la Vigilia Pascual, compartiremos, en esta vida y para siempre, la victoria de Jesús sobre el pecado y la muerte, y permaneceremos en comunión con él en el corazón de la Trinidad.
