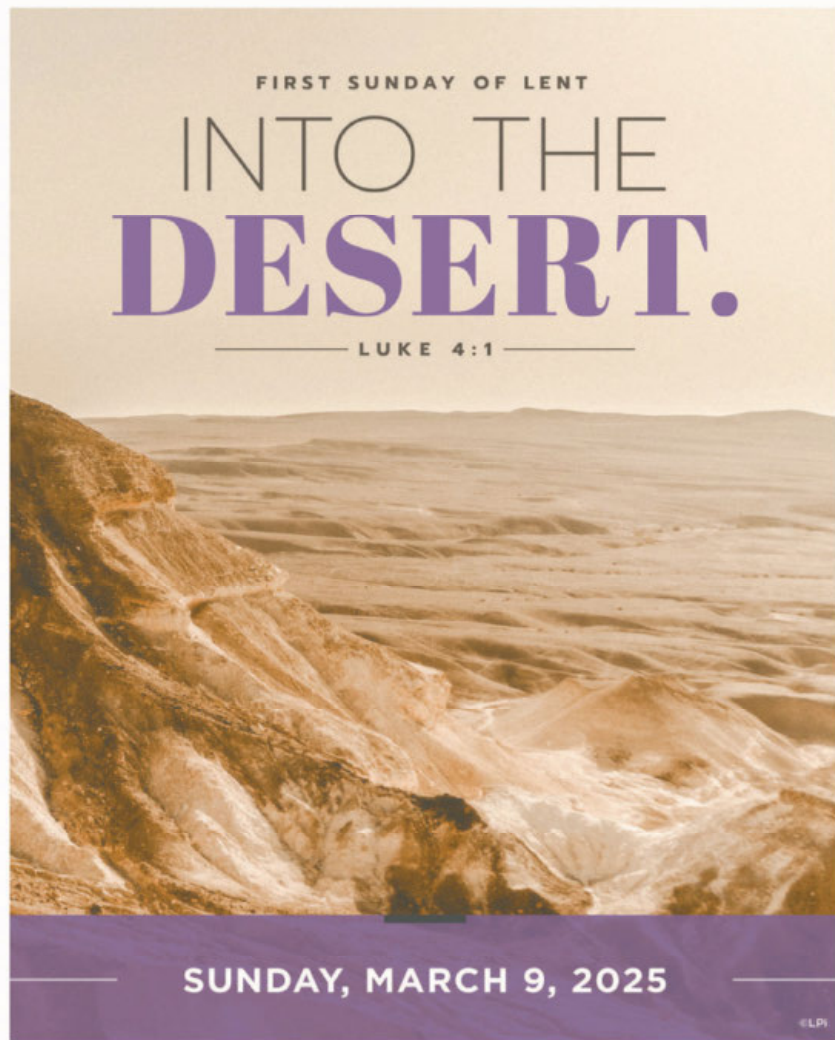

**Ministry to Sick and Homebound**—Please contact the parish office when a parishioner is sick or hospitalized. We will schedule a visit and Communion call, as appropriate. Due to patient confidentiality, the parish is not automatically notified of hospital admissions.

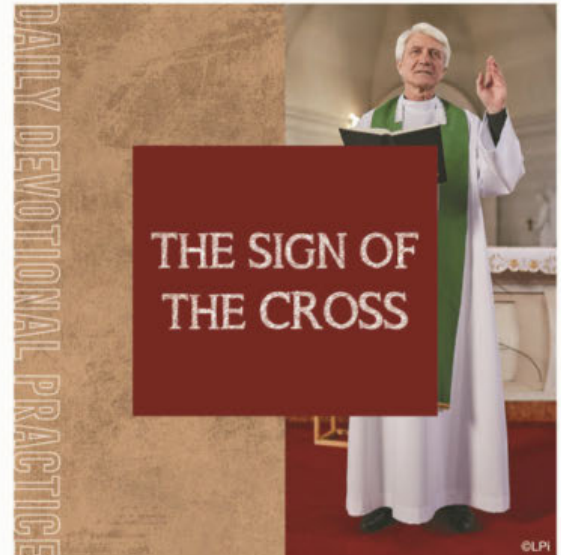
## Live The Liturgy Inspiration of the Week

## A FINANCIAL REMINDER

A gentle reminder that to fully fund the operations of St. Peter's Church and School, our weekly stewardship needs to be at \$16,000.00. When we do not reach that weekly benchmark we have to look for other ways to make up the difference so that we can pay the bills and pay the salaries of the employees who work at the church and the school, and keep the pastoral work of our parish moving forward.

In the stewardship way of life, "the parishioners' tithe to their parish is the **primary and foundational** means by which they support the ministries of the parish." (Dio. Of Jefferson City) Put more simply, our Sunday collection should pay for the day-to-day operating costs of our parish.

That \$16,000.00 represents what it takes to meet the weekly operating expenses of our parish, meaning the church AND St. Peter's School. Some parishioners fail to grasp that the school does NOT have a budget separate from that of St. Peter's Church. There is only one budget, because just as the Altar and Rosary Society, or the PSR program is a function of St. Peter's Church, so is our school. It is the same for all parishes.

We gratefully thank those of you who have prayerfully considered increasing your weekly tithe to the parish. We hope all parishioners will prayerfully consider giving a little more each week so that St. Peter's can continue to flourish in the same manner as it has in the past.

## UN RECORDATORIO FINANCIERO

Un amable recordatorio de que para financiar completamente las operaciones de la Iglesia y la Escuela de San Pedro, nuestra colecta semanal debe ser de \$16,000.00. Cuando no alcanzamos ese punto de referencia semanal, tenemos que buscar otras formas de compensar la diferencia para que podamos pagar las facturas y los salarios de los empleados que trabajan en la iglesia y la escuela, y mantener el trabajo pastoral de nuestra parroquia en marcha.

En el estilo de vida de la colecta, "el diezmo de los feligreses a su parroquia es el medio **principal y fundamental** por el cual apoyan los ministerios de la parroquia". (Diócesis de Jefferson City) En términos más simples, nuestra colecta dominical debería pagar los costos operativos diarios de nuestra parroquia.

Esos \$16,000.00 representan lo que se necesita para cubrir los gastos operativos semanales de nuestra parroquia, es decir, la iglesia y la escuela de San Pedro. Algunos feligreses no comprenden que la escuela NO tiene un presupuesto separado del de la iglesia de San Pedro. Solo hay un presupuesto, porque, así como la Sociedad del Altar y el Rosario, o el programa PSR es una función de la iglesia de San Pedro, también lo es nuestra escuela. Es lo mismo para todas las parroquias.

Agradecemos profundamente a aquellos que han considerado en oración aumentar su diezmo semanal para la parroquia. Esperamos que todos los feligreses consideren en oración dar un poco más cada semana para que San Pedro pueda seguir floreciendo de la misma manera que lo ha hecho en el pasado.

**(PRACTICING) CATHOLIC –  
WHAT THE DEVIL DOESN'T HAVE**

Mini Reflection: The devil knows that Jesus is human, so he uses all the best tricks he has for getting humans to break. The devil will try these things with us, too — this Lent, and throughout our lives. But how can we resist? We're only human. What do we have that the devil doesn't have?

**What the Devil Doesn't Have**  
The devil knows all the rules. The devil knows all the Bible verses. He probably knows them better than you do (certainly better than I do).

He knows them so well that here, in today's Gospel, he thinks he can outsmart the Son of God. He thinks he can out-argue him.

See, the thing you need to know about the devil is that he could have a master's degree in theology. Maybe even a doctorate. But have you ever met a master's student, or even a doctoral one, who doesn't have a particular passion for what they're studying? I sure have.

The devil didn't rebel against God because he didn't understand God's will. He rebelled because he understood God's will perfectly — and he didn't like it.

The devil knows that Jesus is human, and so in today's Gospel he employs all the very best tricks he has for getting humans to break. Physical hunger. Insecurity and a desire for power. The yearning to appear learned and wise.

The devil will try these things with us, too — this Lent, and throughout our lives.

It doesn't work with Jesus, because, of course, Jesus is not just human. He can feel temptation, but he will not submit to it. But how are we supposed to do the same? We're not divine. We're just human.

Well, here's the thing. We may be only human, but as Christians, we have a secret weapon. (No, it's not a master's degree in theology. Some of you may have that, but it probably doesn't make you holier.)

We have a love of what the devil has renounced — those things belonging solely to God. Truth. Joy. Humility. Sanctifying sacrifice.

Let the love of those things carry you through this Lent, and beyond.

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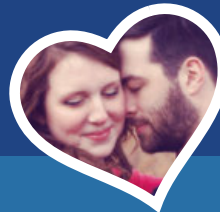
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
