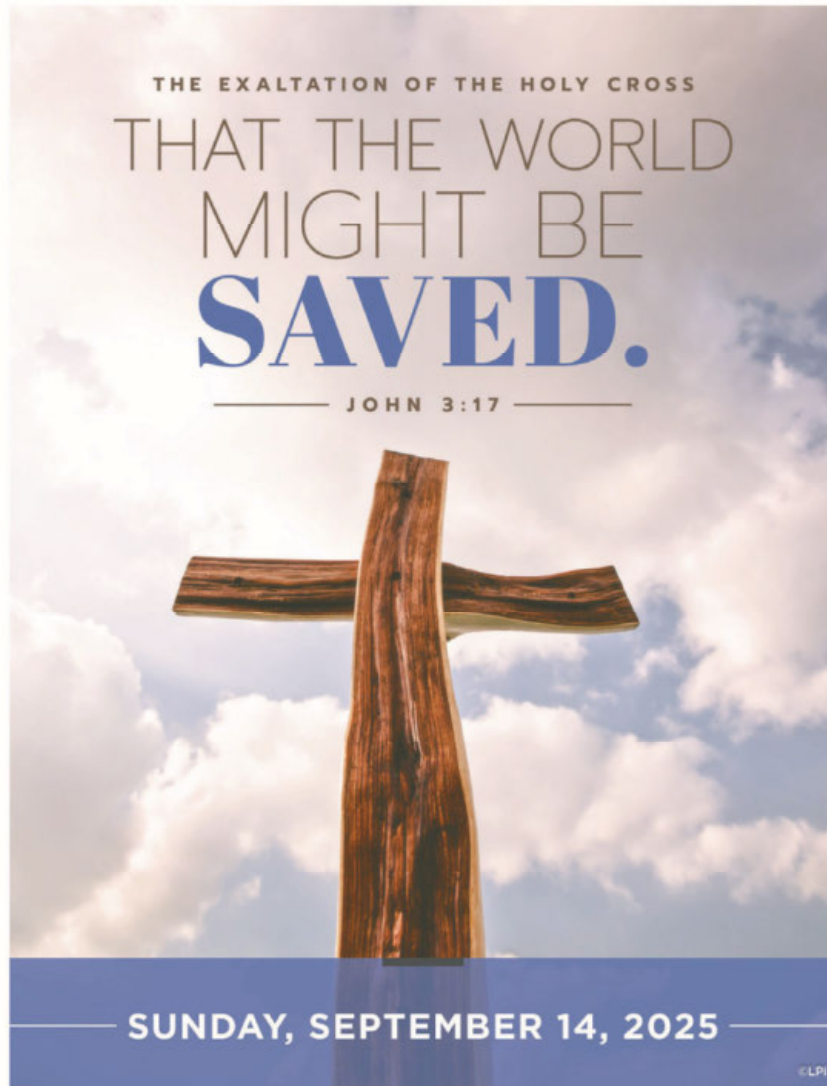

REST IN PEACE, BISHOP GAYDOS

Bishop Emeritus John Gaydos died Saturday, September 6, at the age of 82, at St. Agnes Home in Kirkwood, Missouri. He served our diocese well, leading us through seasons of change and challenge, pointing us toward hope and reminding us of God's boundless mercy.

His wake and visitation will be from 3 to 7 p.m. on Monday, September 15, at the Cathedral of St. Joseph with a Vigil Service and prayers at 7 p.m. The Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated on Tuesday, September 16, at 10 a.m. in the Cathedral of St. Joseph, with Metropolitan Archbishop Mitchell T. Rozanski of St. Louis presiding and Archbishop Emeritus George J. Lucas of Omaha, Nebraska, preaching the homily. The Mass will be celebrated with priests of the diocese and Archbishop Shawn McKnight. All ceremonies are open to the public.

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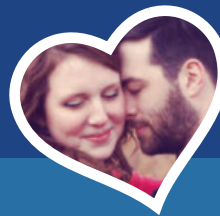
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
