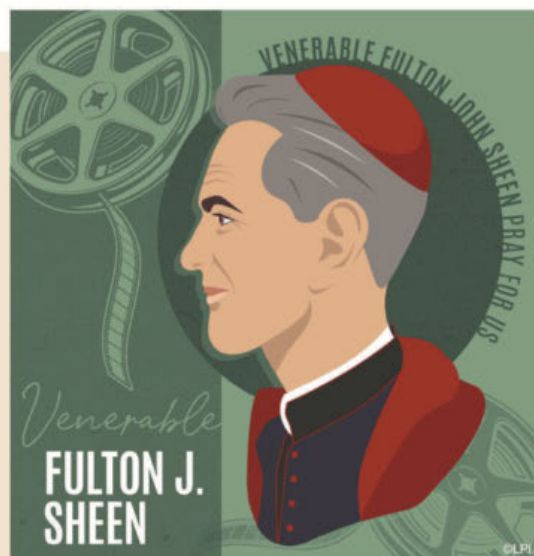

### December 16-17: *Gaudete Sunday*

The third Sunday in Advent is called Gaudete Sunday, or Rose Sunday. Gaudete is the Latin word for rejoice and this Sunday takes its name from the introit for the day: "Rejoice in the Lord always: again I say, rejoice."



On Gaudete Sunday rose-colored vestments are worn and we light the rose candle in the Advent Wreath. Despite the somber readings of the season of Advent, which has as its secondary theme the need for penitence, the readings on the third Sunday emphasize the joyous anticipation of the Lord's coming.

### 16-17 de diciembre: *Domingo Gaudete*

A pesar de las sombrías lecturas del tiempo de Adviento, que tiene como punto secundario tema la necesidad de la penitencia, las lecturas sobre el tercer domingo enfatiza la gozosa anticipación de la venida del Señor.

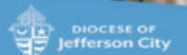

## Why Do We Celebrate Our Lady of Guadalupe?

The title "Our Lady of Guadalupe" is another name for our Blessed Mother, Mary. Many English-speaking people mistakenly see her as only a Hispanic symbol. She belongs to ALL of us for she is the mother of Jesus. Mary has appeared on earth under many titles and this is just one of those. Pope St. John Paul II proclaimed her the "Patroness of the Americas". North America, Central America, and South America. She is the patroness of the entire New World. Her appearance to Juan Diego and the resulting miracles

precipitated the conversion of over nine million people within seven years of her apparition. Her Mexico City shrine is the most visited Catholic shrine in the world. As Our Lady of Guadalupe, Mary has an indigenous appearance, whereas in her European apparitions, such as Lourdes in France and Fátima in Portugal, she looks European. Taken together, these apparitions show that Mary is truly the mother to all peoples and that she wants to reach out to us as we are.
