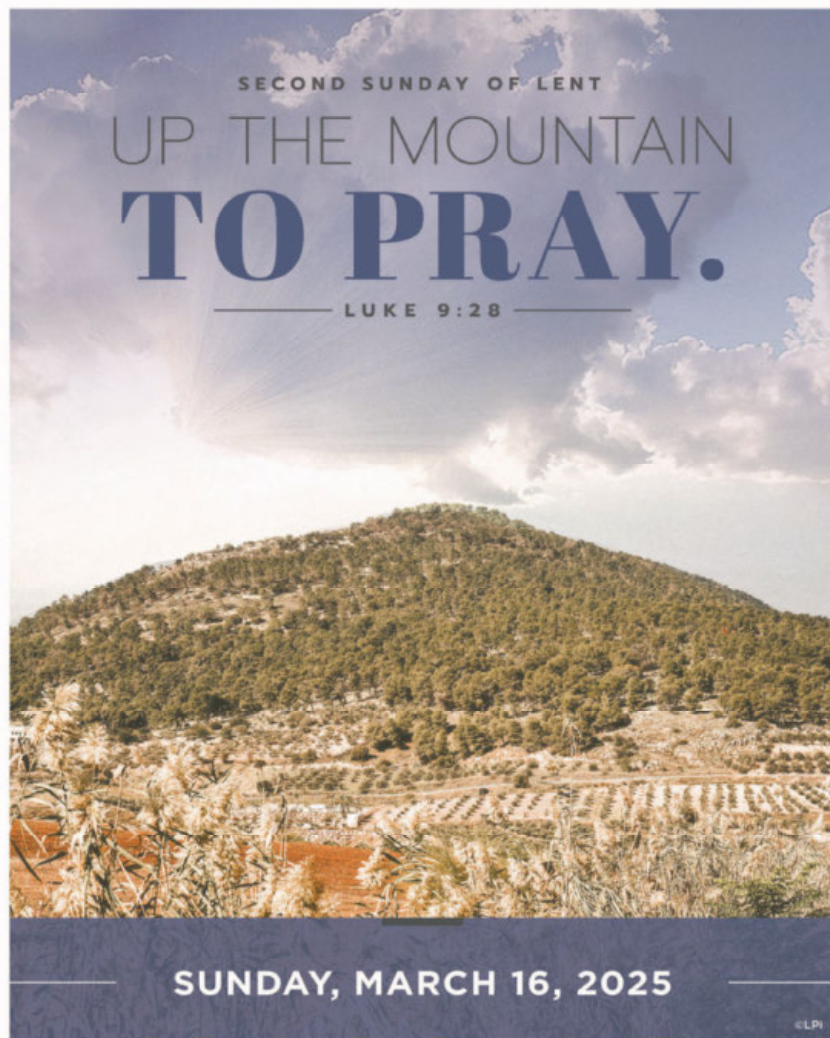

Ministry to Sick and Homebound—Please contact the parish office when a parishioner is sick or hospitalized. We will schedule a visit and Communion call, as appropriate. Due to patient confidentiality, the parish is not automatically notified of hospital admissions.

At the International Science and Engineering Fair (ISEF), Josephine Reinke and Lia Cubero qualified to compete at the state level.

Josephine Reinke received the prestigious NASA Earth System Award 2025, an honor bestowed upon only one student in the competition.

Lia Cubero, Sethuli Jayasundera, and Josephine Reinke distinguished themselves by winning the Thermo Fisher Scientific Junior Innovators Challenge, where they were the only three students selected from the competition, earning all three awards for St. Peter School.

At the Missouri Junior Academy of Science (MJAS) competition, our representatives also demonstrated exceptional performance.

In the Environmental Science category, Josephine Reinke secured 1st place. In the Biochemistry category, Sethuli Jayasundera achieved 2nd place. In the Microbiology category, Lia Cubero earned 1st place and Reagan Thompson attained 2nd place.

Additionally, Lia Cubero was recognized as the overall winner of the MJAS Fair for having the Best Middle School Science Fair Project.

We extend our congratulations to these 8th graders and their dedicated teacher.

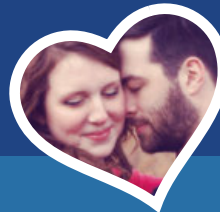
