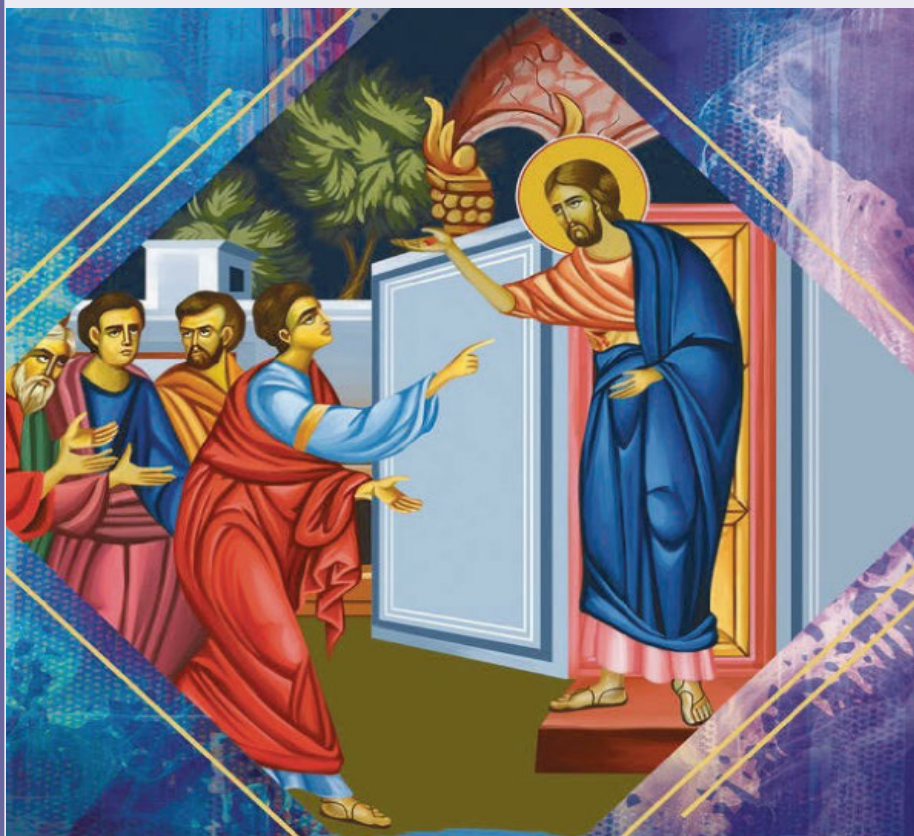

Obituary of Pope Francis

Pope Francis, the first pope from the Americas, died at the age of 88. Born Jorge Mario Bergoglio on December 17, 1936, in Buenos Aires, Argentina, he was the son of Italian immigrants who instilled in him a deep sense of faith. In 1958, he joined the Jesuit order, a decision that would define his commitment to social justice and education. Ordained in 1969, he steadily rose through the clerical ranks and in



1997 he was named coadjutor archbishop of Buenos Aires, assuming full leadership of the archdiocese the following year. Known for his unassuming lifestyle, he rejected luxury, opting instead for public transportation and a modest apartment. He battled health problems during his life with bravery and good humor. It was a life that took him from an impoverished childhood in Buenos Aires to leader of the Catholic Church's 1.3 billion believers as 266 pope. Elected pope on March 13, 2013, he assumed the Petrine ministry following the shock resignation of Pope Benedict XVI, who became the first pope to step aside since 1415. Inspired by St. Francis of Assisi, who gave up his wealth and chose to live in poverty, Bergoglio took the name Francis. The momentous decisions he made will go down in history but he lived his life with an unwavering humility and kindness.

Obituario del Papa Francisco

Papa Francisco, el primer papa de América, falleció a los 88 años. Nacido como Jorge Mario Bergoglio el 17 de diciembre de 1936 en Buenos Aires, Argentina, era hijo de inmigrantes Italianos que le inculcaron una profunda fe. En 1958, se unió a la orden jesuita, una decisión que definiría su compromiso con la justicia social y la educación. Ordenado sacerdote en 1969, en 1997 fue nombrado arzobispo co-adjutor de Buenos Aires, asumiendo la plena dirección de la arquidiócesis al año siguiente. Conocido por su estilo de vida modesto, rechazó el lujo y optó por el transporte público y un apartamento modesto. Luchó contra los problemas de salud durante su vida con valentía y buen humor. Fue una vida que lo llevó de una infancia empobrecida en Buenos Aires a líder de los 1.300 millones de creyentes de la Iglesia Católica como Papa número 266. Elegido Papa el 13 de marzo de 2013, inspirado por San Francisco de Asís, quien renunció a sus riquezas y eligió vivir en la pobreza Bergoglio adoptó el nombre de Francisco.

Las trascendentales decisiones que tomó pasarán a la historia, pero vivió con humildad y una bondad inquebrantables .

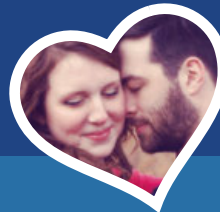
